Preparation: This antibody was produced from a hybridoma (mouse myeloma fused with spleen cells from a rat) immunized with mouse recombinant protein of CXCL14.

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Thymus chemokine-1 (TCK-1 or CXCL7) is a member of the CXC subfamily of chemokines. Mouse TCK-1 shares 72% amino acid sequence identity with rat TCK-1.

Reconstitution: Reconstitute the antibody with 200 µl sterile PBS and the final concentration is 500 µg/ml.

Stability: Lyophilized samples are stable for 2 years from date of receipt when stored at -70°C. Reconstituted antibody can be aliquoted and stored frozen at < -20 °C for at least for six months without detectable loss of activity.

Remarks: This antibody detects specifically mouse CXCL14 with WB.
